Dear Teachers,

The PTA is continuing to offer the "Teacher Grants" program this year. The Teacher Grant program is designed to fund enriching, educational experiences for the students. If you have a need that meets the criteria of the program, please consider submitting the attached application. Grants will be awarded by a majority decision of the PTA Board of Directors based on available funds. Grant requests can be made throughout the year however keep in mind that distribution of funds are first-come, first-served.

Please complete the application, have it signed by Mrs. Keech, and place it in the PTA mail slot in the workroom or email it to our **PTA VP of Grants** directly at <u>wesptagrants@gmail.com</u>.

Criteria

- Teacher Grants should provide wide-range student enrichment.
- Teacher Grants are not intended to be used for staff development and/or related expenses.
- Materials purchased through the Teacher Grant Program should benefit Wakefield Elementary School and should remain as school property.
- Teacher Grants are meant to provide funds for projects for which other funding is not available. The PTA will consider whether there may be other sources available for the money requested.
- There are two types of Teacher Grants available. *Individual* teacher grants have a limit of \$300. *Grade level* or *department* grants (ie art, music, etc.) have a limit of \$500.
- Once approved, the requesting teacher may choose one of the following purchasing options:
 - 1. Purchase the items with the expectation that the PTA will reimburse you, or
 - o 2. Submit an invoice from the company with whom you wish to purchase your items

If you purchase the items on your own, please submit a PTA Check Request Form (also found under Helpful Links & Forms on the PTA website) along with the receipt to wesptagrants@gmail.com. **PTA Check Requests must be submitted by June 30th of the school year in which the grant is awarded**. Our school year budget closes on July 1st and checks will no longer be written for that school year after that date.

- The teacher (or group of teachers) applying for the grant must be a member of the WES PTA in order to be considered.

We hope that you will take advantage of this program to provide the best education and experience we can give our children.
